Oral Diagnostic Clinic

Vision: The Oral Diagnosis Branch seeks to achieve the highest quality of oral care through accurate diagnosis of patients, promoting awareness of the importance of preventive oral care, and educating patients and the community about the correct preventive and curative measures to maintain oral and dental health..

Mission: Oral diagnostics work to identify and diagnose diseases and conditions that affect the mouth, jaws and healthy structure of the face. This includes infectious diseases, tumors, immune diseases, genetic diseases, and conditions related to soft and bone tissue in addition to conducting laboratory and clinical tests to assess oral and dental health. These tests include radiology tests, allergy tests, oral function tests, and medical imaging. In addition to developing the appropriate treatment plan for each case, whether it is through medical or surgical treatment.

Objectives : The objectives of the Oral Diagnosis Branch at the Faculty of Dentistry include several aspects of medical, educational and research services. Among these objectives is to provide an accurate and comprehensive diagnosis of health and pathological conditions related to the mouth, jaws

and teeth .Training students on the skills of evaluating and diagnosing oral cases effectively, using the latest diagnostic technologies and tools, developing specialized educational programs aimed at qualifying students and trainees in the field of oral diagnosis, enhancing their knowledge and clinical skills, providing advisory and guidance services to patients, enhancing communication and cooperation with other medical departments and centers to achieve integration in oral health care and contribute to improving public health..

Peripheral Diseases and Surgery Clinic

Oral Surgery Clinic
